
Objective of the Kick-Off Meeting

Why?

- Realise concrete pilot projects & UCAPs.

How? Regional team in Thailand (coordination), India and Japan. Helpdesks / coordinators in all nine (9) countries. Cross-country *thematic clusters* experts.

What else?

Support *business* cooperation.

Design, produce and disseminate *audio-visual* content.






Cross country thematic cluster experts (NKE) with strong EU thematic knowledge



The Quadruple Helix Approach






Urban Cooperative Action Plan (UCAP)

- Identify key 4-Helix stakeholders
- Effective matching & coaching
- Identify key concrete projects
- Streamline communication (e.g. social media groups)
- Follow-up regularly (online)
- Define decision-making mechanism
- Develop implementation roadmap
- Remain at project-level work
- Promote self-initiatives by stakeholders

UCAP / Pilot Projects / Competitive Fund II URC






- Based on **IUC** Asia experience
- Promote city engagement for short term actions within the city or thematic clusters & UCAPs.
- Encourages cities to propose **innovative** and **sustainable** pilot projects in the short term that benefit the sustainable urban development.
- Applications must be submitted by the **EU cities**, since the benefit should be primarily for them.
- Moreover, this will inspire other cities to replicate actions, thus creating a regional community of practice.
- Time: 2022 2023
