















Analytical definition of territorial units (non-official) which are workable from a bottom-up perspective.







The main objective was to offer all neighborhood residents convenient events to participate within walking distance of their home.

Analysis was improved phase after phase through ongoing assessment in ArcGis of distance traveled by participants and filling in gaps when it became evident that some people weren't participating because the events were too far away.













Need to include worldview of indigenous peoples into technical decision making. This meant including Kume Mongnen: "good living", which is central tenet of Mapuche-Huilliche philosophy. This resulted in affording recognition to cultural significance sites, mostly related to environmental protection, which puts proposal in line with UN Sustainability Goals in Urban Development.








MAIN CHALLENGES LOOKING FORWARD

- A crucial component of peri-urban areas are wetlands. Through participatory process it was confirmed that there needs to be more thorough management of this areas and in this step a continually working roundtable must be formed in which all stakeholders are represented: academics, private sector, indigenous peoples, neighbors and key public services. This is one of our main guidelines and current task.
 - There is a necessity for flexibility and adaptation to a constant situation of crisis worldwide. This means always thinking outside of the box and searching new avenues for alternative models of planning.
- Due to aforementioned crisis, the NIMBY phenomenon continues to grows. It's imperative to engage in constant and meaningful processes of education and participation in all phases of public policy making





The Toy Library-living lab should become a place of:

- democracy by promoting community planning;
- creativity, where it is possible learning how to make craft-toys through cheap and cheerful materials, like chalks or natural objects;
- equality by welcoming women and girls to play, participate at the decision-making processes;
- cooperation with the whole territory by building networking relationships;
- accessibility, opening the use of the space to all people.




The gender sensitive approach for urban spaces and playgrounds



Evidence has shown that there is a disproportion in the use of playgrounds and schoolyards. Football pitch is often positioned in the central space hosting few athletic boys, while girls and unsporty boys are pushed to the fringe.

The re-design of play places such as "school yards and playgrounds" through a gender sensitive approach can provide an important contribution to deconstruct gender stereotypes and the inequalities starting from early age








The Goal




